Seven Reasons to License Your Dog!

1. A Montgomery County license can be traced 24 hours a day, 365 days per year.
2. Licensed dogs are housed at the shelter for 14 days.
3. A license distinguishes a *straying* dog from a *stray* dog.
4. Provides legal proof of ownership.
5. Licensed dogs are eligible for the shelter's vacation registration program.
6. License fees are the major source of funds for the Animal Resource Center.
7. IT'S THE LAW!
